1 Introduction

The package *e-mm* is just a wrapper around Ralf S. Engelschall's MM library. This package contains the MM version 1.1.3. We packaged this library because it is used in many of our programs; the package is thus made available together with our own sources.

The package *e-mm* is needed for e.g. the following e-tunity packages:

- **e-trx**: the TRX transaction server relies on *e-mm* shared object libraries;
- **webserver**: the packaged Apache webserver has built-in XML support;

2 Installation

The installation is very straight-forward: the archive `e-mm.tar.gz` is unpacked, which creates a subdirectory `e-mm/` holding all the sources. A `make install` in that directory does the job. All headers and libraries are installed under `/usr/e/`.

Alternatively, you can obtain the ready-to-install RPM from <http://public.e-tunity.com>. User `root` can install this package using `rpm -i rpm-file`.
